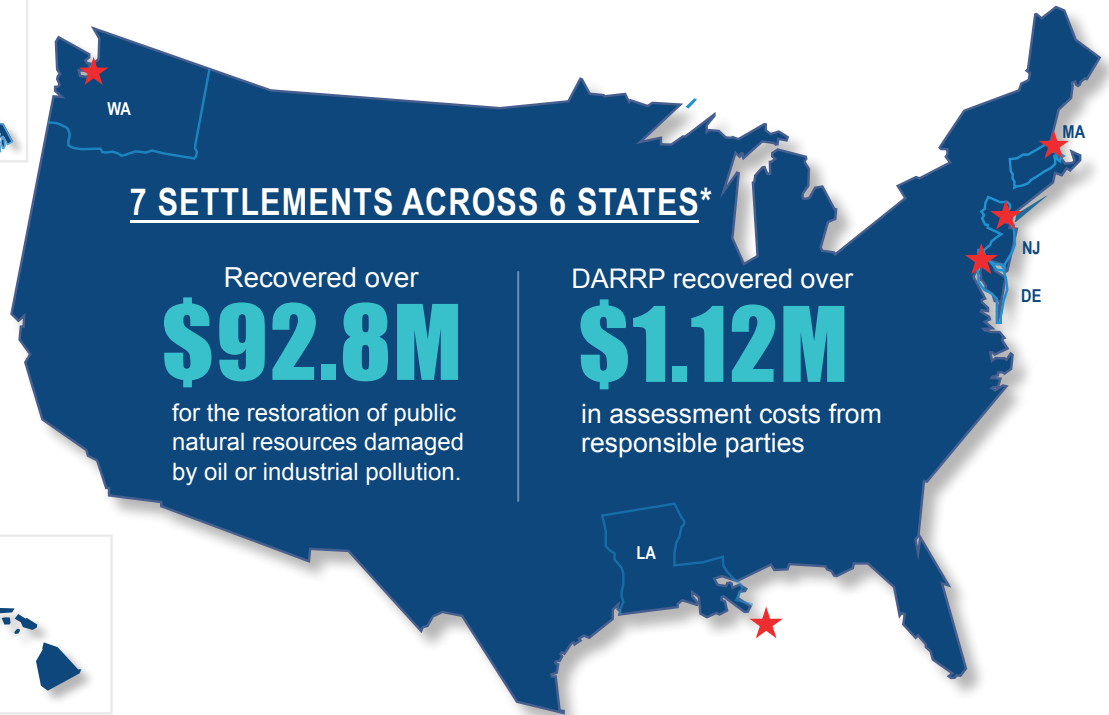

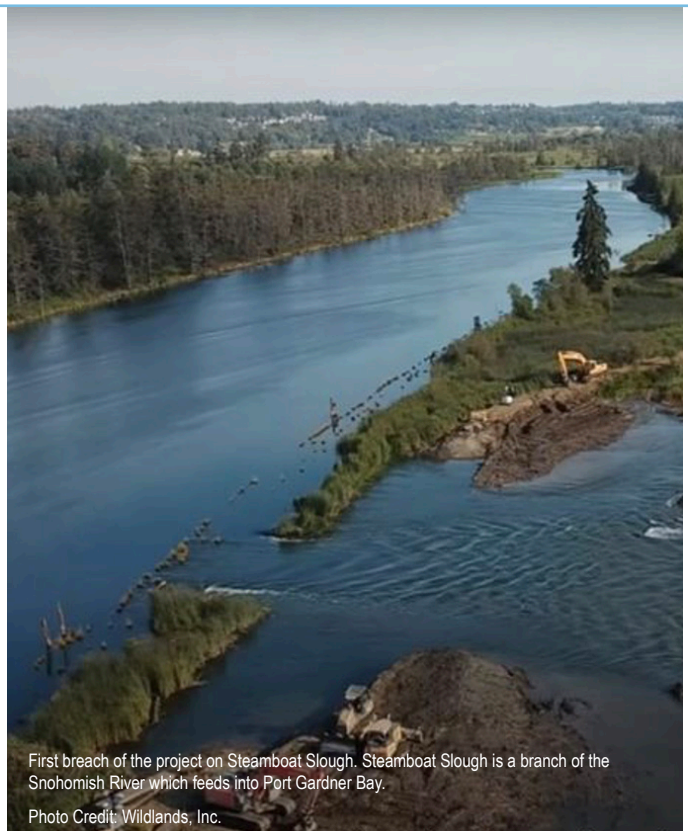

For example, Port Gardner Sound Initiative Blue Heron Slough Mitigation Bank (WA) - 353 Acres Restored.

Finalized six publicly reviewed restoration plans that authorize over \$3.73 billion in future restoration to address pollution impacts from NRDA incidents. In addition NOAA and our co-trustees released five draft restoration plans for public review.
